

Rope Shapes

Equipment:

Long piece of rope.
Blindfolds

Description:

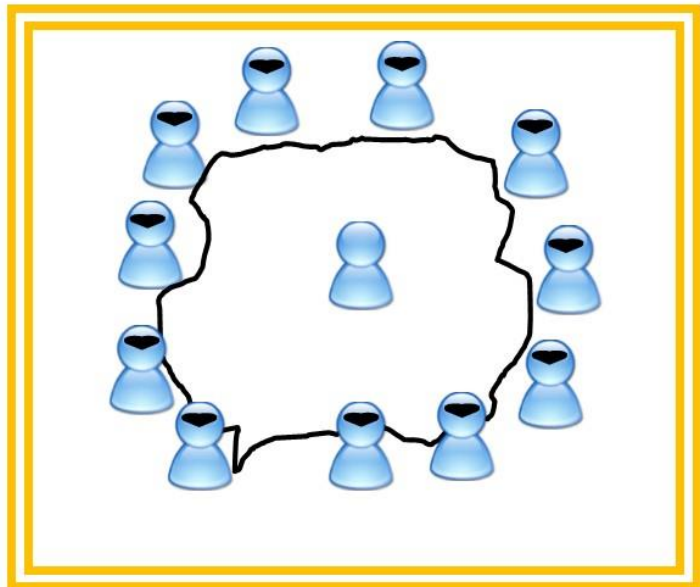
Children who are blindfolded have to place the rope in a shape given to them by the teacher being directed by one pupil who is not blindfolded who is stood in the middle of the rope.

Set Up:

Place the rope on the floor in a random circle shape. Children have to stand by the rope before placing their blindfolds on.

Rules:

Only blindfolded children are allowed to touch the rope.
Children are not allowed to take off their blindfolds until the task is complete or the teacher instructs them to.



Adaptation:

Director is only allowed non-verbal communication.
Place throw down spots on the floor which children must not step on.

Discussion:

How easy was the activity?
Did the director give effective instructions?
What would you have done better if you were the director?
Did you work well as a team?
What would you do differently if you had to do the activity again?
